Minimum Qualifications:

- Carpentry, roofing, siding, insulation work, drywall installation and finishing, mill work, cement finishing, remodeling, general contracting, cabinetmaking
- Knowledge and use of the following: hand tools, power tools, blueprint reading, site preparation and layout, footings and foundations, framing floor construction, framing wall construction, framing roof construction, exterior finish, interior finish and estimation
- Computer experience is necessary
- Participate in required Teacher Induction program

Enrollment in Penn State Teacher certification program Minimum Requirements:

- High school diploma, along with formal training in Carpentry.
- Must have a minimum of four years of full-time, wage-earning experience in Carpentry.
- Must possess or be willing to attain a PA teaching certification (Carpentry/Carpentry CIP 46.0201).
