Enrollment in Penn State Teacher certification program Minimum Requirements:

- High school diploma, along with formal training in Dental Assisting.
- Must have a minimum of four years of full-time, wage-earning experience, or two years full-time wage-earning experience in dental assisting and a bachelor's degree.
- Must possess or be willing to attain a PA teaching certification (Dental Assisting CIP 51.0601).
