Pennsylvania ProStart Cake Decorating State Champions

On Thursday, February 27, 2025, at the Penn Stater Conference Center, Alanis Baez (LH) and Jeralys Sanchez (CL), students in the Lebanon County CTC Pastry Arts program, brought home the state title-2025 Pennsylvania ProStart Cake Decorating Champions. Over 14 teams from across the state had 100 minutes to decorate a twotiered cake. The students used multiple cake decorating techniques, displayed teamwork, safety, sanitation, multiple pastry techniques and followed the theme of nature. Alanis and Jeralys designed an "Under the Sea" themed cake that included a tropical island made of Rice Krispies treats, fondant crab and seashells, and gingerbread trunk palm tree with piped chocolate palm fronds all resting on a poured sugar sea. The tiered cakes were adorned with a blue whale, shark, sea horses, silver fishes, clown fish, and sea turtles. The base was covered in piped seaweed, and edible meringue coral reef with sea urchins, clams, and sea anemones. "The students executed their cake flawlessly. I couldn't be prouder; they represented the school and pastry program to the highest level." Chef Brian Peffley stated. This is the second year in a row that students from the Lebanon CTC Pastry Arts program won the state title.


Medical Assistant Clinical Rotations Internships at WellSpan Health Offices


